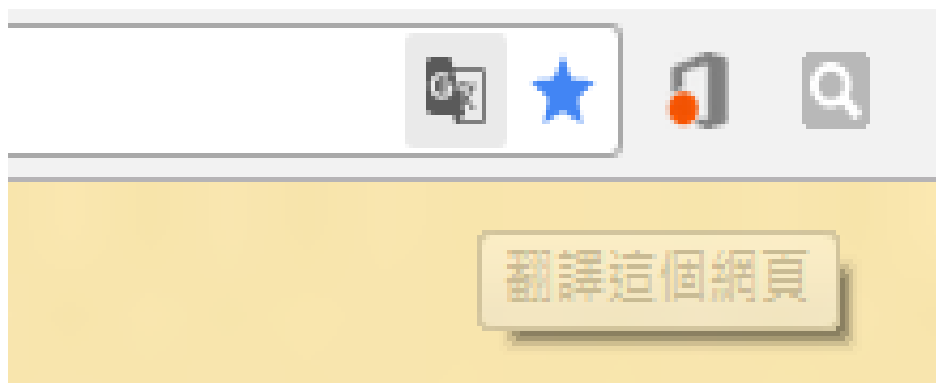

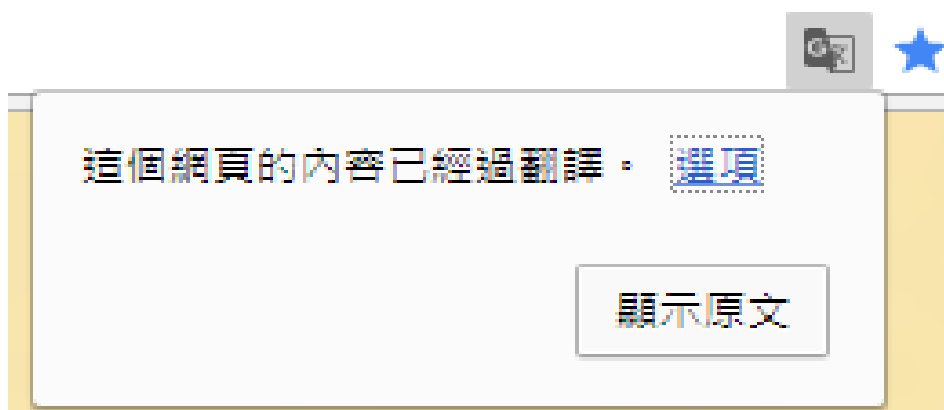


4. To get the MT output in non-Chinese languages, you need to complete the procedure above first.

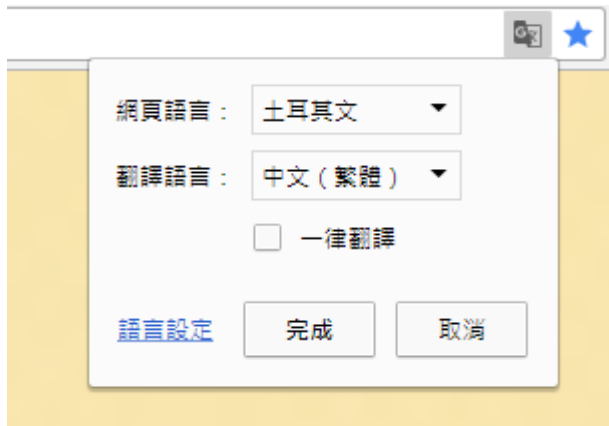
5. Left click  on the upper right menu
